

2012 Study Abroad General Requirements

Health Insurance and International Student Cards

IMPORTANT: In accordance with university policy, university students going abroad through a university sponsored program *must* register and show proof of insurance coverage. Fees

2012 London Law Consortium Spring Semester Program – England Open to ALL students at ABA accredited Law Schools

Students at LLC Consortium Schools

- \$500 non-refundable application fee
- \$10,000 program fee
 - \$6000 DUE November 20 (or within 30 days of application; no student may start the program without paying the first installment
 - \$4000 DUE January 20
- **Once paid, programs fees are non-refundable**

- The University of Kentucky College of Law

Students at Non-Consortium Schools

- \$500 non-refundable application fee
- \$12,000 program fee

- \$6000 due November 20 (or within 30 days of application; no student may start the program without paying the first installment)
- \$6000 DUE January 20
- **Once paid, program fees are non-refundable**

**2012 Arcachon Summer Program – France
Open to ALL students at ABA accredited Law Schools**

\$100 non-refundable application fee

\$6,800 program fee, includes housing

- Payment schedule will be announced before program
- Once paid, program fees are non-refundable

**2012 London Intersession Program – England
Spring Break
Open to LLC Consortium Students ONLY or students enrolled in the Spring Semester Program**

- \$100 non-refundable application fee
- \$2700 non-refundable program fee (DUE January 31, 2012) or
- \$750 non-refundable program fee for students participating in the 2012 LLC Spring Semester Program
- **Once paid, program fees are non-refundable**

After being accepted you WILL BE required to agree to the following terms and WILL BE asked to sign a release to participate in our Study Abroad Program. DO NOT SIGN THIS NOW. PLEASE REVIEW and a form will be sent to you after your acceptance in the program.

Agreement and General Release: I understand that participation in the Study Abroad Program is entirely voluntary and that any program of travel involves some element of risk, including travel to, from, and within Europe, and risks due to accident, disease, and international events.

I agree that, in partial consideration of the University of Iowa sponsoring the Study Abroad Program(s) and permitting the me to participate, I hereby assume the risk of such travel and study abroad, and further agree that I (including my parents, guardians, heirs and legal representatives) shall not attempt to hold the University of Iowa, its trustees, officers, employees, faculty, agents, and cosponsoring institutions and their agent(s) liable for any injury, death, or loss to person or property sustained by me while participating in or arising out of any travel or activity conducted by or under the auspices of the University of Iowa Study Abroad Program.

I am fully aware that this release includes also all of my travel arrangements. I have been informed that they are my sole

responsibility. The University, its trustees, officers, employees, faculty, agents, and cosponsoring institutions and their agent(s) are not liable in any way for any type of injury, death or loss that I might suffer as a result of those arrangements.

I also understand that I am fully responsible for any travel, hotel, and subsistence expenses incurred before and/or after the official dates of the Study Abroad Programs.

Study Abroad Program Changes or Termination: I understand that the University reserves the right to make cancellations, changes, or substitutions in cases of emergency or changed conditions in the interest of the group. In the event of program cancellation or termination or in the event of student withdrawal due to the issuance of a US State Department Travel Warning or Alert affecting the location of the program all tuition payments (except for utilized room and board fees) will be refunded to students.

I understand that any refunds made for the Study Abroad Program where payment is made to the University will be in accordance with published University policies for the academic year in which the Study Abroad Program occurs, unless otherwise stated. Payments are due as indicated by schedule and I assume liability as of those dates.

Voluntary or Involuntary Withdrawal or Dismissal: I understand that all students are subject to University regulations, Study Abroad Program guidelines, and laws of the host country. In the event of violation of these, academic failure, or behavior which is detrimental to other students of the Study Abroad Program, the Director of the Program shall have the right to dismiss me from the Program. The Director's decision will be final and may result in the loss of academic credit and Study Abroad Program fees.

I will pay for all costs arising out of my voluntary or involuntary withdrawal from the Study Abroad Program prior to its completion for whatever reason, including withdrawal caused by illness or disciplinary action, as set forth above. I agree that I (including my parents, guardians, heirs or legal representatives) shall not assert claims or hold the University, its trustees, officers, employees, faculty, agents, and cosponsoring institutions and their agent(s) responsible for any costs or losses resulting from said events.
