

## **ACT NOW, TO REGISTER FOR THE 2008 DEAN'S CUP**

The time is approaching for the showdown. On May 22, 2008 at the *NEW* Blue Top Ridge Golf Course near Iowa City, the alumni of Drake Law School and The University of Iowa School of Law will return to the links for the annual Dean's Cup golf match.

Led by its captain Judge Arthur Gamble the U of I will attempt to wrest the coveted cup from the victorious clutches of Drake, and its captain Justice Mark Cady.

This event is for all law graduates, faculty, staff and students of Drake Law School and Iowa College of Law– of every skill level – to support their law school, and, at the same time, raise some money for the Iowa Legal Aid, whose funding has been dramatically reduced in recent years. In addition, a lawyer who is not a graduate of either school may also participate in the best shot format by declaring temporary allegiance to one of the two schools at the time of registration. Representatives were unavailable for comment concerning the rumour that Masters Champion Zach Johnson will receive an honorary degree from Drake.

As in past years, part of the event will be a Ryder Cup format with players competing in two person and singles matches. Participants in the Ryder Cup format will be selected by their respective team captains.

The other participants will compete in a four-person best-shot event. Golfers are invited to create their own teams to compete in the best-shot event. Points are awarded for both the Ryder Cup and best shot format to determine the winner.

Following golf there will be awards, food, beverages, and a charity auction with Drake and Iowa athletic tickets, photos, sports memorabilia, and time share vacations, including a week at Hilton Head. Proceeds of the auction will also be contributed to Iowa Legal Aid.

The field will be limited to the first 100 eligible golfers, including the match play participants.
