## General Information

**Meetings:** The Professional Responsibility Overview: Updates and Strategies for Ethical Practice CLE program on Friday, September 30, 2005, will be held in the Main Lounge of the Iowa Memorial Union, on the University of Iowa Campus, in Iowa City. The registration fee for this program is \$170.00. In order to guarantee that you will have materials, it is necessary to preregister. You will still need to print out the registration form and return it in the mail with your payment. If you wish to pay with a credit card, there is a \$1.00 processing fee.
