Blanket Permission: Students must request the class to be recorded but the faculty do not require any further approval. The class will be recorded and can be viewed once complete.

Permission to View: Students must request the class to be recorded but the faculty must approve the request before the student will be able to view the recording. The class will be recorded but cannot be viewed until approved.
