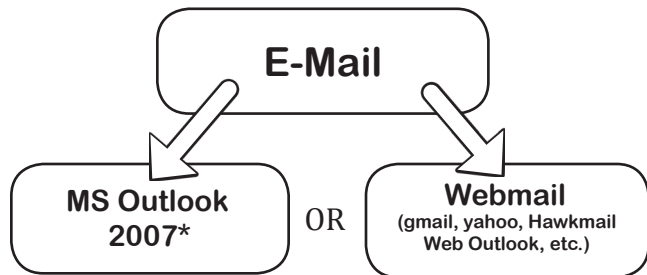


Subscribe to THE DOCKET using RSS

Easily access what's posted on The Docket and the College of Law News page with Real Simple Syndication ("RSS"). Here's how:



Click the "Twitter & RSS" button on the Iowa Law website, then click "Subscribe with Outlook 2007."

This will launch Outlook on your computer, prompting you to configure the RSS feed.


Use a third-party web application to direct RSS feeds to your e-mail address. Try:

- feedmyinbox.com
- reblinks.therssweblog.com
- shootthebreeze.net/blogalert

RSS Reader

Click the "Twitter & RSS" button on the Iowa Law website, then choose a reader from the list.

OR

Browse to The Docket at blogs.law.uiowa.edu/docket and click on the RSS symbol at the top of your browser window. It looks like this: 

This will bring up reader options onscreen.

iGoogle Page

Click the "Twitter & RSS" button on the Iowa Law website, click the "Google" button, then select "Add to Google Homepage."

Click the + next to an item to read its entire text.

You can also add e-mail, calendar and many other widgets to customize your iGoogle page.

Mobile Device

Search online or in your phone's app store for ready to download directly to your phone (as for iPhone, Blackberry or Droid), or try a generic mobile RSS reader, such as:

- [netnewswire](http://netnewswire.com) (iPhone)
- litefeeds.com
- m.google.com (search for Reader)

* The full version of Microsoft Office 2007 is required. It is available for under \$10 at the UI Book Store, currently located in the Old Capitol Town Center on Clinton St. See www.book.uiowa.edu for Book Store information.

Note that some services will ask for the RSS feed address, and some will want the blog address.
