The Editorial Board of Volume 34 of The Journal of Corporation Law (JCL) is proud to announce that The Institute for Law and Economic Policy (ILEP) has selected JCL to publish its 2009 symposium. ILEP is a public policy think tank dedicated to consumer welfare by improving access to the justice system for consumers. Recent hosts of ILEP symposia include Duke University School of Law, Columbia Law School, Vanderbilt School of Law and Washington University Law School.

The topic for the 2009 symposium is “Compensation of Plaintiffs in Mass Securities Litigation,” and it will focus on the economic and legal issues in measuring and distributing damages stemming from class action securities litigation. Tentative schedule of speakers includes Professors James Cox and Francis McGovern, of Duke Law School, Professor Donald Langevoort, of Georgetown University Law Center, and Professor Hillary Sale, among others.

The symposium will take place in the spring of 2009 in a west coast venue to be determined.
