The Journal of Corporation Law's Editorial Board is pleased to announce that the Symposium on Invention, Creation, and Public Policy will be an accredited Iowa continuing legal education (CLE) event. Attorneys admitted to practice in Iowa will be able to apply their attendance at the symposium to their CLE requirement for 2009. This symposium will provide a great opportunity to earn CLE credits while learning about an interesting and developing area of the law.

Please note the following:

- Under Iowa's Continuing Legal Education for Lawyers Rules, every attorney admitted to practice law in Iowa is required to complete a minimum of 15 hours of legal education each year.
- The Commission requires attorneys to complete two CLE hours devoted exclusively to ethics every two years. This requirement requires a separate form and hours earned through attendance at the Symposium will not count toward fulfillment of the Commission's ethics requirement.
- Each attorney is required to submit a written report to the Iowa Commission on Continuing Legal Education describing their completion of the required hours and accompanied by proof of satisfaction of those hours.
